The Spirit of Divine Interception: Avoiding Disasters, Embracing Wealth, and Perfecting Your Spiritual Insight

I. A Parallel Universe

- A. The things which are **seen** (natural technologies) are based on the template of things that are **invisible** (spiritual technologies).
- B. We as humans live in a parallel universe. (Matthew 22:23–29)
 - 1. We understand the natural world through use of our five senses.
 - 2. We understand the spiritual world through the sixth sense, the technology of faith.
- C. Parallel: "Aligned side by side."
 - 1. Our earthly existence is a carbon copy of a higher life borrowed from the spirit world.
 - 2. We are actually spirit beings having a body experience.
 - 3. Living life as if only the natural body experience is real means we won't be prepared for diabolical intentions, demonic messages, or even hell.
 - 4. Principles embedded in the fabric of creation govern how life is to work.
 - 5. The world we live in becomes the world of effect: What's been produced in the spirit is actualized and manifested and felt on earth.
- D. Divine interception: A powerful, dependable law of the Kingdom.

- 1. We can depend on the laws of the spiritual world as much as we can depend on the laws of the world, the laws of nature.
- 2. When the world of the spirit touches the natural world even for a short moment, something supernatural happens in the intersection. **Example:** Jesus, Elijah and Moses at the Mount of Transfiguration.
- E. **Grace:** The God-given ability to operate in the now and in the spirit at the same time. God intercepts our mistakes long before they can bear fruit.

II. Disasters in Commerce

- A. The marketplace: There's no real cultural transformation without it.
- B. Disasters in the marketplace are directly connected to the *lack* of divine interception or of *having missed one*, and consequences can be drastic.
- C. Dr. Myles' calling: To awaken the spirit of the corporate Joseph in the nations.
 - 1. Leaders must know how to take dominion of the 7 mountains of culture.
 - 2. One bad business deal can shatter dreams, affect employees and families.
 - 3. The spirit of divine interception can bring warning and encouragement.
- D. **The spirit of divine interception:** God getting to you before the devil does. (Acts 27:8–12)
 - 1. We can be bewitched by our desire for money and disregard God's voice.
 - 2. **When God says "Don't do it,"** it doesn't matter how good you are, you'll lose out if you don't listen.
 - 3. **The enemy sets you up**, sees you disregard God's word to you, waits until you're past the point of no return, then unleashes disaster on you.
- E. **We desperately need to understand** the technology of divine interception. We can avoid the damage and the loss of decisions that are not Spirit-directed.

III. Examine Your Life

- A. Lenses dictate and drive our subconscious belief systems.
 - 1. Our subconscious runs our lives.
 - 2. It's our true beliefs, not just what we say we believe, that actually drive and affect 90% of our decisions.
- B. **Lenses:** How we think about, how we see or think through things.
 - 1. **Many of us were born with** lenses that affected how we saw people or life.
 - 2. We may color things that don't have color just because we have that bend.
 - 3. We need God to deliver us from our lenses if they don't line up with His way of seeing things!
- C. Filters: How we feel our way through things.
 - 1. **Every person's** worldview is affected and driven by filters they have over their heart.
 - 2. Jesus might need to wash our filters in order for us to perceive things accurately.
 - 3. **The more healed in soul a person is,** the more sensitive and powerful are their filters in the Lord's hands to bring forth divine interception. (Psalm 26:2)
 - a. **Forgiving people** for their trespasses against us can help Jesus wash our lenses.
 - b. Fear as a filter can override a feeling God gives you that tells you it's okay to do something. It causes you to doubt His word.
 - c. A dirty filter can deceive us to think all things are good, when they are
 - d. The **traditions of men** can affect our lenses and filters too, making it hard for God to intercept us when we trust traditions more than what He is saying to us.
- D. **Ask the Lord to test you**, revealing your lenses and your life's emotional navigation system. How were they impacted by things you went through?

E.	Speed can be the key to avoiding a bullet from the very pit of hell. We need our filters to be razor-sharp, to hear God well and right away when He calls.
